6.0 Public Hearing

6.1 Proposal for Negotiations with the Alexander Valley Teachers' Association

The Board will hold a public hearing to discuss the Board's and the Association's joint interest in negotiating the following concerns:

1. To make general updates and to delete obsolete clauses in the certificated contract
2. To develop an article to govern instances when two teachers wish to share one assignment or when one teacher wishes to take a partial temporary leave of their assignment
3. To develop an updated article governing certificated evaluation
4. To clarify and update the article on work hours to reflect participation in district and school committees
5. To discuss the possibility of stipends for specific extra duties
6. To clarify and update the process for granting professional development credit
7. To specify professional adjunct duties
8. To implement "agency fees"
9. To explore ways to increase teacher compensation
10. To develop an article governing common planning time
11. To clarify and refine the article regarding early retirement
12. To discuss the issue of probationary and permanent status for certificated staff
